Winter Cup: Top 32 qualifiers on stipulated qualifying round. Match play on current handicap.

McDonald Mugs: One over 17 and one under 18 handicap. Match play on current handicap. Partners aggregate nett score. Lowest handicap to scratch.

Santoft Rosebowl: Members past and present with a current handicap and are 18 years or over. 18 hole medal qualifying Saturday. Top 24 and ties play 36 holes stableford Sunday. 18 hole consolation stableford for non-qualifiers.

Transport Cup: Second Sunday in June. 20 man team. Hawkestone, Rangatira, Rangitikei, Marton.

Masters Cup: Best nett (55 years & over).

Medal Cup: Top 3 and ties on qualifying rounds qualify for final to be held on stipulated round.

Bill Fullerton-Smith Memorial: Top 3 & ties on qualifying rounds qualify for final to be held on stipulated round.

Coleman Cup: Top 3 and ties on qualifying rounds qualify for final to be held on stipulated round.

John Hogg Cup: Top local man stableford played at Christmas Cheer tournament.

Shootout: Best 5 of 20 rounds (nett) on stipulated rounds. 19th qualifier drawn from non qualifiers then reserves in order of best nett.

Bevan Bremner Memorial Trophy: Top shootout qualifier

Adrian Duncan Cup: Winner of shootout.

NOTICE TO MEMBERS

DO'S AND DON'TS FROM THE COMMITTEE

Slow Play: There is no excuse for slow play and the committee recognises the lowest handicap player as the captain of the team of his/her four to assist the speed of play.

Trundlers: must not be taken on the tees or greens or left unattended in the line of play.

Litter: Please use the boxes at each tee for rubbish. The course belongs to you so please treat it with respect.

President & Captain's Privilege: The president and captain shall have the right to enter the field whenever they desire.

The Clubhouse: This building is an asset to our club. Members are asked to do their share in keeping it tidy whenever they leave the premises.

Saturday Competitions: Unless otherwise advised, members will make up their own fours and are able to tee off from 11am.

Players arriving after 1pm are not eligible for the day's competition unless prior arrangements have been made with the starter. Cards must be handed in no later than 5.30pm.

Morning rounds may be played but these players must be through 9 holes before 11am and must notify the club captain beforehand.

Cards: The player keeps his opponent's card and enters the score after each hole. At the end of the round, the player is responsible to see that their card is filled in correctly, signed by the scorer and handed in to the club captain for the day's results. Incorrect cards will not be accepted and the club captain has the discretion to disqualify any person who signs an incorrect score card.

Coronation Medal: Silver. NZ-wide Medal Competition.

DO'S AND DON'TS FROM THE COMMITTEE

Slow Play: There is no excuse for slow play and the committee recognises the lowest handicap player as the captain of the team of his/her four to assist the speed of play.

Trundlers: must not be taken on the tees or greens or left unattended in the line of play.

Litter: Please use the boxes at each tee for rubbish. The course belongs to you so please treat it with respect.

President & Captain's Privilege: The president and captain shall have the right to enter the field whenever they desire.

The Clubhouse: This building is an asset to our club. Members are asked to do their share in keeping it tidy whenever they leave the premises.

Saturday Competitions: Unless otherwise advised, members will make up their own fours and are able to tee off from 11am.

Players arriving after 1pm are not eligible for the day's competition unless prior arrangements have been made with the starter. Cards must be handed in no later than 5.30pm.

Morning rounds may be played but these players must be through 9 holes before 11am and must notify the club captain beforehand.

Cards: The player keeps his opponent's card and enters the score after each hole. At the end of the round, the player is responsible to see that their card is filled in correctly, signed by the scorer and handed in to the club captain for the day's results. Incorrect cards will not be accepted and the club captain has the discretion to disqualify any person who signs an incorrect score card.
